Four Supply Chain Models



What is the cost structure? The total certification cost consists of the costs related to the auditing services and the NEPCon RSPO Programme Rea. The auditing fee depends on the size and complexity of the company and its Chain of Custody system. This is specified in our proposal. The NEPCon RSPO regramme fee is a fixed fee of 300 BUR.
